The United Nations bodies encourage North-South, South-South and triangular cooperation for the development of Agrifood.

According to the UN website, to address the interrelated issues of poverty and hunger, South-South and triangular cooperation in agriculture can play a key role. PRESENTATION OF AGROBUSINESS MEDAFRICA 2023


