



The exhibition will be held from the 1st of July, 2020 till the 4th of July, 2020.


The food industries in the Kingdom is advanced and is ranked second in terms of quality and reach most of the markets of neighboring countries.

The volume of investments in the sector of food, supply, agricultural and livestock industries amounted to one billion dollars.




Food products are difficult to enumerate, and it is difficult to quantify the quality, characteristics and specifications if it. Every year, the world is witnessing hundreds of different kinds of new food products, different types and sources of raw materials.

The total number of establishments operating in the food industries registered in the third industrial chambers (Amman, Zarqa and Irbid) in 2014 reached 922 local establishments compared to the number of establishments in 2008 with 852 establishments registering an increase of 2.8%

The exports of the sector constituted 34% according to the 2014 census issued by the Jordanian Chamber of Industry. Of the total industrial exports, this large number of exports reflects the quality and advantages of Jordanian products in this sector.


Exports of processed food products from Jordan have increased significantly since the beginning of 2000 - about 2.6% between 2003 and 2013 in terms of value in US dollars.



Jordan's imports of processed foods far exceed its exports - US \$ 2,170 million of imports in 2013 compared to US \$ 535 million in exports.

Much of this is due to the importation of low-processed food products based on agricultural outputs that the agricultural sector cannot Jordanian produce competitive quantities such as cows, sugar, processed grains and oils (other than olive oil) such as sunflower oil and palm oil. While the dairy sector in Jordan is strong and vital for a country with little water, for many types of dairy products it is in a disadvantageous position to compare with countries with more favorable climatic conditions for the dairy industry and as a result Jordan imports more than five times the value of its products Dairy products.

As a result, imports of processed foods come to Jordan from a wide range of countries. The main suppliers of "food supplies" in the region are Saudi Arabia, Egypt and the United Arab Emirates, which have similar food sectors in many respects to those of Jordan. The EU



countries, if taken overall, are also major suppliers of processed food, including "food equipment", although only the Netherlands are among the top 10 suppliers. Equally important are suppliers of low-processed food commodities such as meat and milk. The main suppliers are Brazil, the United States, Argentina and Australia.

The Food, Supplies, Agricultural and Livestock industry sector is one of the most important Jordanian industrial sectors which has a multiplicity and diversity of products offered in local markets. Such products are permanently linked with the consumer's health and safety as food items constitute a major source for the energy, as well as the building up of the human body since they contain proteins, fats, sugars, starches in addition to vitamins and minerals. This sector has many advantages that are intertwined and interconnected with several other industrial sectors and that serve to form an associative kind of integration with other sectors. This sector is one of the most significant pillars of food security, as it works to increase the added value of the agricultural sector.




The Food, Supplies, Agricultural and Livestock industry sector includes the following sub-sectors:



Jordan is also a member of the World Trade Organization and an important regional centre and one of the most desirable in investment locations in the region.




Contribute in the effort of trade and service development and reinforce them, including the small and medium enterprises.
